Welcome to the Community Enrichment Center! The CEC is dedicated to meeting the needs of our community during the remote learning day. Our program offers a great place for children to be for remote learning and is designed to meet the needs of today's working parents and their children. Participants in our program are involved in age-appropriate activities, which are planned and supervised by experienced staff. Our program is licensed by the state of New Jersey. We welcome your comments and suggestions for program improvement. By working together, staff and parents can develop a high-quality program for our children.

Your child's safety is our first priority:

- Your child will be in a small group with a dedicated staff person. These groups will not mix during the day, and staff do not move from group to group unless necessary.
- All staff and children will follow School District/Office of Licensing (OOL) social distancing guidelines.
- All families are required to sign a waiver prior to their child's first day of programming.
- All staff and students are expected to follow NJ Department of Health, OOL, state health and safety protocols while at the Center.

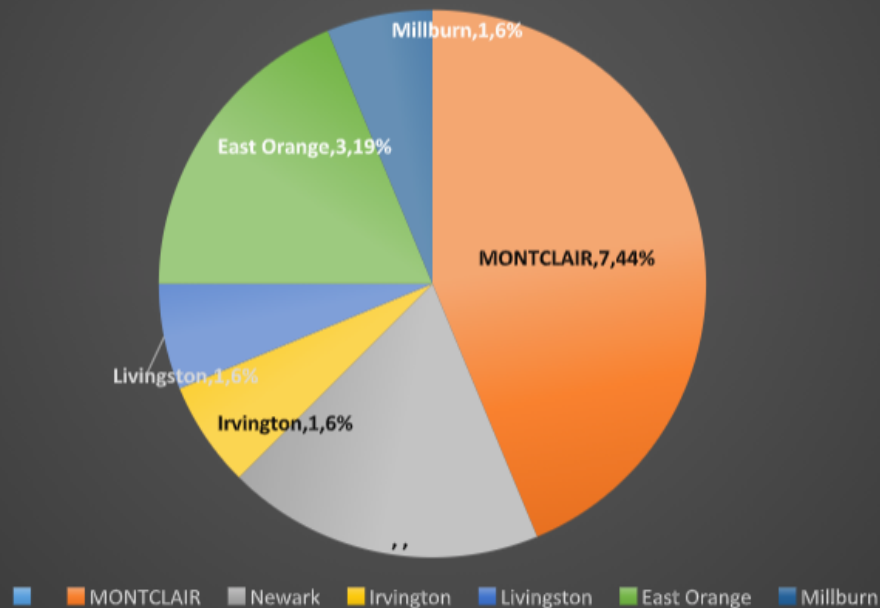

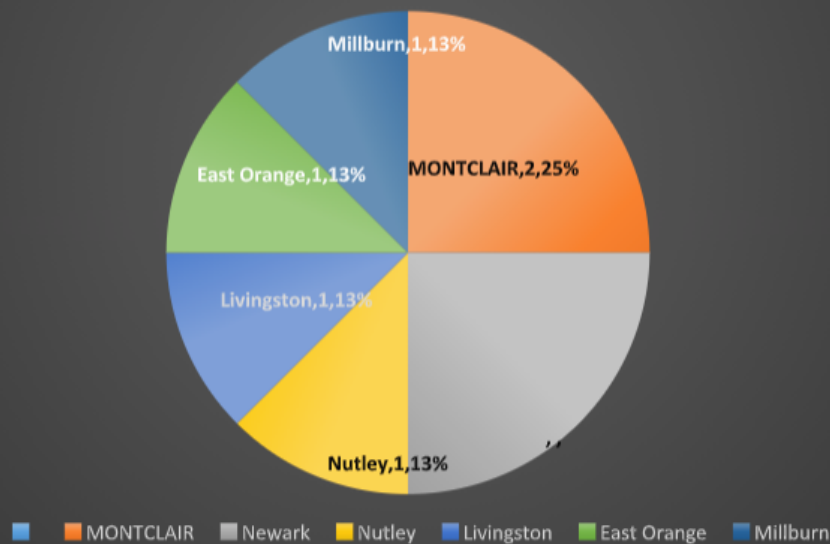
